Rules of the Race:

- Each team must have no more than 5 people (1 person rides the bed).
- Team members must sign disclaimer.
- All members must be in contact with the bed at all times.
- This will be a “Double Eliminations Race.” Two beds will race at once. Winners of the race will race the winners of another race, etc. The last winner of each category and the final race will receive an award.
- All teams will need to display their name on the bed so that it may be visible to the audience.
- Participants are encouraged to wear costumes with the “bed rider” wearing appropriate pajamas for a family event, and decorate their beds (except Slumberland beds), to provoke silly, sponsored or socially relevant themes.
- The rider must be on the bed as long as it is in motion and may not help at any time in the propulsion of the bed. If the rider falls off, the bed must come to a complete stop until the rider is back on.
- Beds may be an existing twin size bed, or one specially made for the event, however it must be sized for a twin mattress (Slumberland will provide the mattresses for all bed entries). There must be a headboard and footboard, or push bar that do not exceed the width of the bed. Beds should have a minimum of four wheels, so situated to make the bed stable and safe. Wheels of any size may be used. You may have swivels, steering, or permanently fixed wheels. Note: fixed wheels are more than adequate.
- Slumberland will provide a “loaner” bed for bed-less contestants. One of the most fun parts of a bed race is building your own bed.
- The judge’s decision is final.
